

EXTRACT OF DECISIONS TAKEN AT THE 105TH (EMERGENCY) MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON MONDAY, 29TH MARCH 2021/ 15 SHA'BĀN 1442AH IN THE SENATE CHAMBER

The Senate at its 105th (Emergency) meeting held on Monday, 29th March, 2021 deliberated on a number of urgent matters and took the following decisions:

- 1. Deadlines for Submission of Reports by Various Committees of Senate Senate frowned at the non-compliance of the various Committees/ Units/ Offices with the directive on the submission of reports by specific deadlines as given at the 104th meeting of Senate. A new deadline of Thursday 15th April, 2021 was again in respect of the following:
 - a. Reviving Contact with Qatar University Research Opportunities (Prof. Goke Lalude and Dr. O.F Liadi were to give the report)
 - b. FUO International Conference: Academic staff members were strongly encouraged to submit Conference proposals
 - c. Senate Statutory Committees' & Annual Reports
 - d. Follow-Up on 28 Feb-1 March 2020 FUO-NASFAT-NES Workshop (Dr. Jimoh-led Committee)
 - e. Report on New programmes (Drs. O.F. Liadi & H.S. Bolarinwa)
 - f. Modular MIT and Harvard University Online Courses: ALL programmes were to submit their selections to the Curriculum Committee.
 - g. Two New Programmes in the Department of Electronics and Earth Sciences: details of basic requirements and cost must be submitted.

- h. PGD and M.Sc. Programmes in Mass Communication: experts' input must be incorporated.
- i. List of Postgraduate Students: updated list of Postgraduate students to be submitted to the Registrar.
- j. Guideline on Online Registration and Assessments by students: ICT to build in this mechanism and confirm its operationality to Senate at the next Senate meeting

2. Review of 2020/2021 Academic Calendar

Senate reviewed the 2020-2021 Academic Calendar as follows:

- First Semester Examinations will now begin with GNS courses on Thursday 28th & Friday 29th April, 2021 and end on the 8th of May, 2021.
- ii. Mid Semester/ Eid-l-Fitr break Sunday 9th of May Sunday 16th of May 2021.

- iii. 2020/2021 Second Semester begins on Monday 17th May, 2021.
- iv. New students admitted after the 16th of April will have their admissions deferred to the second semester.

3. Ratification of Approvals by the Vice Chancellor on behalf of Senate

Management Review of SDC Recommendation on-OLUWO,
 Babatunde Ahmed (FUO/18/0063) 4OO Level Economics

Senate ratified Management's review of SDC's recommendation to expel **OLUWO**, Babatunde Ahmed on allegation of forgery of the University's official receipts. Senate resolved that OLUWO, Babatunde be rusticated for the 2020/2021 academic session. He would resume academic activities in 2021/2022 Academic Session subject to the following conditions:

- a. His father should write a letter of undertaking that his son will be of good behavior,
- b. He will be summarily expelled without appeal in case of any act of misconduct by him in the future,
- c. His father should pay the sum of One Million, Fifty Thousand and Four Hundred Thousand only (N1050, 400.00), being the total of accumulated fees fraudulently manipulated by Oluwo, Babatunde Ahmed from the 2017/2018 session to-date.
- ii. Recommendations of Student Disciplinary Committee (SDC)
 Senate ratified the recommendation of the SDC of the following three students for beating up a student:
- a. Elegbede Babawale (FUO/18/0179) 300 level Bus Admin-Rustication 2020/2021 Session,
- b. AbdulAzeez Faruk Gbolahan (FUO/19/0057) 300 level Mass Comm. -Suspension for 1st Semester, 2020/2021 Session, and
- c. Orire Qasim (FUO/18/0076) 200 level Bus Admin- Suspension for 1st Semester, 2020/2021 Session.

Recommendation of SDC on ISAH, Malik Harkoredeh (FUO/19/0101)
 200 level Business Administration.

Senate ratified the expulsion of the student as recommended by the SDC. He was found guilty of participation in secret/ungodly meetings.

4. Consideration of Applications
