DECISION EXTRACT

Senate at its Special meeting (81st) meeting held on Thursday, 26th July, 2018 deliberated extensively on many issues and the following decisions were taken:

1. New Programmes

During the consideration of the Curriculum, Senate directed that all new programmes that would generate huge financial benefit for the University must be addressed and the minimum requirement should be brought forward for massive campaign (eg. MPA)

2. Entry requirement for Direct Entry Programme

Senate agreed and approved that the result from the National Board for Arabic and Islamic Studies (NBAIS) should be included as direct entry requirement for all programmes in the University.

3. New Courses

Senate directed that all new introduced courses should either be asterisked or a new column created.

4. NUC Resource visit

Senate approved that all new programmes for takeoff in the next academic session with all documents available should be ready for NUC resource visit.

5. SIWES Programme in the College of Management and Social Sciences

Senate observed that some departments in COMAS do not go on SIWES. Senate therefore directed that such departments should come up with practical aspect of their programme.

6. GNS ENTREPRENEURSHIP COURSE

On the GNS Entrepreneurship course the Chairman invited Dr. MUSE, Oke and Mr. BADMUS, W. to a meeting for discussion with a view to review the programme for implementation in the 2018/2019 academic session.

7. FIQH COURSE

The figh course with a zero unit was extensively discussed and Senate observed that for the course to be relevant the course content needed a review.

8. A Committee was set up to look into the requirements needed to commence Masters in Business Administration. The Committee is made up of:
