

## DECISION EXTRACTS OF 90<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON THURSDAY 19<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2019

### 1.0 Consideration of 2018/2019 Summer Examination Results

The results were considered and approved subject to financial confirmation with exception of 400 level Political Science that was stepped down.

### 2.0 Regulations on Summer Programme

Senate resolved that:

- i. The statutesque of maximum of six (6) courses, duration of six (6) weeks and maximum of C grade remains unchanged. Discount on payment for six (6) courses and above has been cancelled, and Fifty Thousand Naira (N50,000.00) per course retained,
- ii. Students who registered up to nine (9) courses in the 2018/2019 Summer Programme should be allowed,
- iii. Maximum of nine (9) courses only should be recorded for students who registered more and that such students should be refunded the excess.
- iv. The rule of replacing the old scores with new ones remains unchanged.
- v. Series of programme that affect lecture periods for Summer at College level should be realigned in consonance with the approved academic calendar.
- vi. New Continuous Assessment (CA) and attendance should be reckoned with, for students who come for Summer.
- vii. Registrar should release a memo to the ICT that henceforth, students who register six (6) courses (maximum) in summer will pay N300, 000.00 without discount.
- viii. Regarding students who were deprived information on permission given to register up to nine courses, the Sub-Dean, CONAS/HOD Chemical Sciences should advise them to write a letter to the Vice Chancellor through the Registrar, seeking for leniency.

### 3.0 Verification of Result for ABDURALMAN Hadizah (FUO/16/0003) 300 Level Accounting

Senate approved the result subject to directive that the HOD should verify the above student's result, using the 2018/2019 Second Semester examination result.

### 4.0 Poor Academic Performance

Senate directed that:

- i. The HOD, Computer Science should guide the 200 level students with poor academic performances.
- ii. The HOD, Mass Communication should guide EGBEBI, Samuel Emmanuel (100 level, FUO/18/0294) on poor academic performances.

#### **5.0 Waiver of MCM 209 (Elective) for MAS/15126 OGUNTADE, Kawthar Olajumoke**

Senate answered the prayer from the HOD, Mass Communication to waive MCM 209 for the student to allow her graduate with her colleagues.

#### **6.0 Disregard to Student's graduation upon Seven Semesters**

Senate disregarded the prayer to allow (ADEBAYO, Islamia Omolara, 400 level Mass Communication) graduate upon seven (7) semesters.

#### **7.0 Provision of Answer Script of AMODU, Oluwadamilola Mujeeb (FUO/18/0116) 100 Level Political Science.**

Senate directed the HOD to forward answer script of the student to the Vice Chancellor through the Chairman, BCOS for an assessment.

#### **8.0 Stepped Down Result**

Senate directed that 400 level Political Science result be stepped down due to lack of merit. *The Registrar was directed to forward a memo* to the Department, warning them to henceforth steer clear of any act that can put the name of the University into disrepute.

#### **9.0 Consideration of the 2018/2019 Second Semester Examination Results (400 level amended result) for CONAS**

Senate considered and approved the result as presented.

#### **10.0 Consideration of the amended 2018/2019 Second Semester Examination Result (400 level Accounting).**

Senate considered and approved the result as presented.

#### **11.0 Consideration of the amended 2018/2019 Second Semester Examination Result (200 & 400 levels Business Administration).**

Senate considered and approved the results as presented.

#### **12.0 Re-draft of the 2019/2020 proposed academic calendar**

Senate directed the Chief Academic Planning Officer (CAPO) to redraft the calendar, taking into consideration, all issues raised at the meeting.

#### **13.0 Ratifications by Senate: Request for Approval to write 2018/2019 Make-Up Examination –**


