

EXTRACT of DECISIONS at THE 98TH MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON FRIDAY 7 AUGUST 2020/ 17 DHUL-HIJJAH 1441 AH AT THE AMINA NAMADI SAMBO HALL, FOUNTAIN UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, OSOGBO

1.0 Consideration of the 2019/2020 First Semester Examination Results

Senate considered the results and directed that:

- a. The result of **ALAFORITI**, Tunde (FUO/17/0102) 300 level BCH *be stepped down* on disciplinary grounds.
- b. The HoD Computer Science should report by 14 August 2020 on **YUSUF**, Oladimeji Desmond (FUO/19/0121) 100 level Computer Science who was discovered to have written the examinations without valid registration for the 2019/2020 session.
- c. The summary page of results for 400 level Industrial Chemistry –should be modified.
- d. The HoD Mass Communication should report by 14 August 2020 why no score was recorded for **ODEWALE**, Rukayat Funmilayo (FUO/19/0203) – 200 level in respect of ENT 201.
- e. All students with many carry-over courses should be properly advised and guided by their Level Advisers. Students whose current CGPA is less than 1.00 should be properly advised and their parents duly notified by their respective Level Advisers.
- f. Only Adjunct Lecturers who have fully complied with teaching and grading rules as certified by the HoDs & Deans and confirmed by Feedbacks from students will be duly paid by the Bursary Unit.
- g. The ICT should forward a comprehensive list of registered students for the 2019/2020 session to the Vice Chancellor's office not later than Friday 14 August, 2020.

- h. College Officers should harvest the list of students who failed to register for the session and communicate it to the Registry for notification of parents/guardians/sponsors.
- i. SDC reports and list of students under disciplinary sanctions should henceforth be brought to Senate meetings that are dedicated to consideration of examination results.
- j. Senate approved that any student with less than 1.00 CGPA at the end of the First Semester of his/her 200 Level will be placed on Probation 1. Should the same status subsist at the end of the Second Semester of 200 Level, such a student will be advised to withdraw, change to another programme for which he may be qualified from 100 level.
- k. Students who failed to register or write examinations should be properly reported to the Senate by 21 August 2020.
- l. The HoD Accounting & Finance should strive to improve student enrollment in Finance. He should also get in touch with the Vice-Chancellor regarding the change of nomenclature from Banking & Finance to Finance.
- m. All parents/guardians/sponsors must receive a copy of the result of their children/wards at the end of every semester.
- n. HoD Econs is to re-present the result of the extra year student **ABDUL-AZEEZ Shukurat**, (MAS/15005)
- o. Henceforth, CONAS will be presenting 300 level Second Semester results for Senate approval only after SIWES scores have been taken into account.
- p. Where a student has failed to write an examination without a valid reason/exemption, the term "AWAITING RESULT" (AR) cannot be rightly used in such a case. Hence, the student would have to repeat (REP) the course.
- q. Students admitted for B.NSc are to transit to 200 Level in Nursing without any extra examination once they satisfy the prescribed conditions for the programme.
- r. Public Administration should be removed from the heading of the results presented by the Department of Political Science.
- s. The heading of results for Part Time Political Science should read "**First Semester of 3 of 5 years**".

2.0 Ratification

Senate ratified the applications from the underlisted students to write their missed examinations at the next available opportunity:

- c. ISHOLA, Barakat Yetunde (MAS/14081), 400 level Accounting & Finance - (ACC 201) on health ground.
- d. TAIRU, Oluwafemi Michael (FUO/17/0329), level Accounting & Finance - (ACC 305) on health ground.
- e. ODUKOYA, Luqman Alade (FUO/19/0077) 100 level Economics – (FUA 101) subject to provision of Bursary endorsed eligibility card.
- f. KEWULERE, Mariam Kikelomo (FUO/19/0111) 100 level Microbiology – (BIO 103) subject to provision of a certified medical report.
- g. KAREEM, Akeem Adewale (FUO/17/0192) 400 level Microbiology – (MIB 405) on health ground.
- h. The application for a resit from **POPOOLA, Sulyman Folami** (FUO/16/0222) 400 level Political Science – (PAD 407) was ratified subject to the submission of his Continuous Assessment (CA) score and enrolment for summer if available.

The application from **DIXON, Princess Anwuli** (FUO/19/0249) 100 level Nursing- (CHM 101, CHM 103, FUF 101 and MAT 101) was ratified subject to a directive that she should personally rewrite the application to replace the one earlier written by her father.

2.1 Poor Writing Skill of Students

Senate frowned at the atrocious language of memos and applications by students and strongly advised that Deans/HoDs and lecturers through whom such are passed to the University to observe due diligence to improve this. Senate noted the need for the employment of competent Lecturers of English Language as a way of improving the students. Prof. A.T. Lawal was directed to come up with a proposal on this before the next Senate.

3.0 Review of ENT 202

Prof. Muse Oke was directed to come up with a report on this by 21 August 2020 for presentation before the next Senate meeting.

4.0 Review of Inter University Transfer

Dr. T. Ayinde was directed to come up with a proposal to the Senate.

5.0 Promoting Payment of Outstanding School Fees

Academic staff members were strongly encouraged to assist the University in the recovery of outstanding fees from students to ensure proper running of the University and prompt payment of salaries.

6.0 Accreditation

HoDs of the eight academic programmes due for NUC 2020 Accreditation were advised to conduct in-house accreditation and submit reports to the Vice Chancellor on or before 21 August 2020.

7.0 MCATI Accreditation

HoD Account was advised to liaise with the Bursar concerning the status of our MCATI Accreditation exercise and report back to the VC by 21 August 2020.

8.0 Outstanding official Reports of Committees


Registrar was advised to fetch the signed reports from the Committees on:
