00. The Chairman welcomed members of Senate to the meeting. He thanked them for their efforts in ensuring a successful conduct of the 2019/2020 Second Semester examinations (online).

1. Consideration of Reviewed Sanctions for Offences (Chapter 8 of New Student Hand Book)
Senate approved the following:
